MEAL SUPPORT FOR MOE-FAS STUDENTS DURING EXTENDED CIRCUIT BREAKER PERIOD

To provide added support for all MOE-FAS students, MOE will be providing meal subsidies to these students during the extended circuit breaker (CB) period from 5 May to 1 June 2020.

MOE will be crediting four weeks of meal subsidies, via students' School Smartcards. Your child will receive \$120.

The School Smartcard can be used to purchase food and essential groceries at some hawker centres¹, food courts², minimarts, convenience stores and supermarkets³.

Students can redeem the meal subsidies at any TransitLink Add Value Machine⁴ once every two weeks, starting from 5 May 2020. The 2nd top-up can be redeemed from 18 May 2020. Pls refer to Annex A for the step-by-step guide on how to redeem through the TransitLink Add Value Machine.

The meal subsidies must be redeemed by 10 June 2020. There will be no extension of redemption period.

If your child has lost his/ her School Smartcard, kindly contact the school at 6560-6866 for assistance on the replacement.

	Students can redeem the eVouchers at any TransitLink Add Value Machines (AVM). (Parents can do this on their behalf.) MOE FAS students can redeem the first top up
	from 5 May to 10 June 2020, while non-MOE FAS students can redeem the first top
	from 5 May to 10 June 2020, while non-MOE FAS students can redeem the first top
	up from 7 May to 10 June 2020. All students – MOE FAS and non-MOE FAS – can
	redeem the second top-up from 18 May to 10 June 2020.

	The meal provision must be redeemed by 10 June 2020. There will be no extension
	of redemption period.
4.	Where can the students use the meal provision in the School Smartcard for
	the purchase of meals?
	There are 146 hawker centres and coffee shops that accept payment of meals using
	the School Smartcard. Stalls that accept payment using the School Smartcard will
	display the EZ-Link logo.

	Purchases can also be made using the School Smartcard at certain convenience
	stores and supermarkets. Please see list of selected merchants (see separate
	document) extracted from the EZ Link website that schools are encouraged to share
	with students and parents.
	Schools should encourage students to make the best use of the subsidies provided
	to them. A combination of take-away meals and groceries would help to maximise
	the subsidies (e.g. older students can cook simple meals).

Step-By-Step Guide on the Redemption Process for eVouchers through TransitLink's Add Value Machines (AVM)

Step 1: Place the card on the reader

Step 5: Check that the new value is correct. Collect the card and receipt.
